Enormous opportunity! By the end of the 2 showcases you will have performed for over 20 casting directors/agents/managers, and you'll receive written feedback to learn from the experience!

Details:

The Showcase is 1 hour and 15 minutes. Students will perform for 10-15 (or more) Industry Professionals (Agents, Managers and Casting Directors). This will be a performance-only format, and the feedback will be Industry Professional written feedback communicated to you at a post-showcase reflection meeting with PTW Executive Artistic Director, Dean Kravitz. Student strengths, opportunities for growth and best next steps, based on Industry Professional feedback, will be discussed in that post-showcase reflection meeting.

There will be a run-through in NJ at PTW the Wednesday before. Students will arrive 45 minutes prior to the Industry Professional Showcase to warm up and prepare. There will be 22 performance slots per showcase. Each song and monologue represents a slot. Students may choose to perform either a 32-bar song or 1-minute monologue, or both. You may sign up for up to 2 slots if you do one showcase, Or up to 4 slots (2 slots in each showcase) if you do both showcases. One or two 30-minute review lessons are required per spot (not included in price for showcase, \$68 per 30-minutes).

* We will hold 12 spots for existing Pro Track students for each showcase until June 30, after which the remaining spots will be available for new Pro Track students. Spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Anyone wishing to have more spots, or having missed the June 30 cut off will be put on a waiting list. Any remaining spots as of August 15 will be offered to the students on the waiting list.

\$475 per spot (you can perform up to 2 slots per showcase: monologue and song, or 2 contrasting songs)
\$68 for 30-minute song/monologue prep private lessons (1 or 2 lessons required for each performance piece)
