Most recently known for originating the role of Squidward Tentacles in Broadway's "SpongeBob SquarePants," Gavin earned both a Tony Award nomination and a Drama Desk Award for his performance in "SpongeBob" on Broadway.

Following his run as Squidward, Gavin portrayed another stage character with a big personality and a crazy costume to match: The Grinch, star of Dr. Seuss' "How The Grinch Stole Christmas! The Musical." The show toured in Chicago and Boston before opening at the Hulu Theater in Madison Square Garden. Gavin has also performed as Mr. Magoo/Ebenezer Scrooge in "Mr. Magoo's Christmas Carol," a series of concerts at Disneyworld's International Festival for the Arts, and in the Disney on Broadway series.
